Quality of Outcomes

Nutrition-related outcomes are measured, and performance, value, and satisfaction are documented. In addition, outcomes are utilized to refine continuous quality improvement plans. For example: staff creates performance improvement goals to improve quality of services.



Quality of Leadership

Nutrition and Dietetic credentialed practitioners are part of the leadership within the organization and profession. There is evidence of supporting volunteer leadership, individual honors and awards, and mentorship. For example: RDN or NDTR is a manager, director, or VP.
